



Submission for 2024 Abuja ECE Conference

Authorship Guidelines

Please adhere to the following instructions when preparing your abstract submission:

Deadline for submission is *September 30, 2024*. Please save the date.

Abstracts should be written in English.

The title of the abstract should be no more than 15 words maximum.

Your abstract should include Background, Aims, Methods, Results, Conclusions and Recommendations and up to 5 keywords.

Your abstract should be between 250 to 300 words maximum (excluding title, keywords and references).

Presentation Guidelines

The 2024 Abuja ECE Conference is an in-person event. All presenters are required to be physically present.

An author is allowed a maximum of two (2) abstract submissions for the conference. Please note, only the first two submissions received will be reviewed.

The primary author must submit the abstract.

The primary author is the corresponding author and will be the point of contact for all communication with ECDI.

Graduate students are encouraged to submit proposals and attend the conference.

Presentation sessions include single or multi-authored papers, posters or case studies. Accepted papers are typically grouped with other papers in a 75-minute session.

Each paper presentation may have one or more authors but should be a single cohesive presentation timed for approximately 15 minutes. Papers on similar themes will be grouped for presentation.

Poster sessions involve displaying posters in hard copy format, which will be presented in person with an accompanying question-and-answer period. These posters can address topics, including theoretical, policy or advocacy, educational, or research-based subjects related to, but not limited to the conference thematic areas.
